

The City of Terrell, Texas, is seeking a new Director of Municipal Development Services. Terrell, located 30 miles east of Dallas, has a diverse population of nearly 17,000 and a trade area population of over 250,000.

Terrell is a home rule city operating under the Council-Manager form of government. The Municipal Development Department is comprised of a nine-member staff and operates with a FY 2015-16 budget of \$861,652. The Director of Municipal Development Services reports to the City Manager and directly supervises the Chief Building Official and the Code Supervisor.

A bachelor's degree in planning, engineering, public administration or a related field is required. Eight years of increasingly responsible experience in municipal planning, urban development, or a closely related field, with four years in a supervisory capacity, is required. AICP certification is highly desired. The salary range for this position is \$85,800 to \$94,660 depending on qualifications and experience.
