- Completing site inspections

- General engineering and construction practices for public infrastructure
- Damage inspection and assessment
- Customer Service Surveyor, design engineer, or construction inspector/manager
- Damage assessment tools skills
- Community and stakeholder collaboration
- Written and verbal communication skills
- Strong computer skills, to include competency in Adobe and Microsoft Office Suite
